Professional Hunter	<ol style="list-style-type: none">1. A letter from your tax agent (dated within the last 12 months), verifying that you are substantially dependant on hunting as a source of income; OR other written evidence (dated within the last 12 months) that you are substantially dependant on hunting as a source of income, e.g. tax assessment and recent contracts;2. Copies of contracts or formal agreements to hunt professionally; and3. A letter that describes the quarry you intend to hunt, stating why the specific category of licence is required, and why a lesser category of firearm could not meet these needs.
